WHAT YOU NEED:

- PRE-REGISTER BY JANUARY 26
- PLEDGE SHEET/PERMISSION SLIP WITH MINIMUM OF \$25 IN PLEDGES (signed by parent)
 - A favorite and comfortable rocking chair for *each person* (doesn't matter what kind or how big, as long as it *ROCKS* and can fit through the door)
 - Comfy clothes, fuzzy slippers, pillow & blanket (it gets cold at 2 am!)
 - Board games, cards, books, *music with earphones only*
 - Bring a snack to share if you'd like
- **HELP US GO GREEN:** bring a cup/mug that you can use for all your drinks



PLEASE DON'T BRING:

Portable TV's, radios/docks, laptops, etc.
Skimpy or revealing clothing (big baggy tees provided if needed)
Homework stays home
